

Jubilee Campus, Nottingham University – Factsheet

Our courses take place on the magnificent Jubilee Campus of the University of Nottingham. Opened in 1999, this modern facility has everything a vibrant and varied summer course could need. All classrooms are equipped with the most modern teaching facilities and audio visual aids. The sports facilities are excellent. There is an indoor swimming pool (on the adjacent campus), large sports hall, tennis courts, and playing fields. As you walk by the lake, amongst the trees and wide-open spaces, it is hard to imagine that the campus is only ten minutes from the centre of the city.
