Our courses take place at the University of Wales, campus at Cyncoed, a specialist sports college on an attractive campus just to the north of the city centre, and within easy reach of the centre by bus. Cardiff, the capital of Wales, is comprised of modern architecture and historic buildings, reflecting the city's changing status from an important trading centre in Victorian times, to its current status as a world famous and popular city. It has a wide range of shops, in the city centre or by the waterside, as well as a wealth of theatres, galleries, cinemas and museums.

- Cardiff is a **residential centre**. All students are housed in **good quality single-rooms** in university flats (6-10 students per flat). Some rooms are en-suite, while others have private basins and shared shower/toilet facilities.
