

# Student Enrolment Policy

2026/1

In accordance with our Equal Opportunities Policy, we will not discriminate against students wishing to enrol on our courses where we feel we are able to meet any specific needs they have. Some of the centres we operate in are not accessible to wheelchair users and so we might have to offer an alternative centre in such cases. We can accept students with sight or hearing problems, as long as they have a helper who can assist them in class and around the campus.

Our courses are accessible for students who have minor learning disabilities and generally function unsupported in mainstream education in their own country; however, if they require more individual or specialised attention, then our courses would not be suitable as our staff are not trained in Special Needs provision.

Students enrolling on Elac Summer courses need to have had some language training prior to attending our course, as we cannot cater for students at A0 (Beginner Level). Classes will start from A1 Level.
